You can use the Import/Export Wizard that is included in Internet Explorer 5.0 or later to import or export favorites and cookies. You can use the Import/Export Wizard to perform any of the following tasks:

- Import existing Netscape Navigator bookmarks from a Bookmark.htm file.
- Import exported Internet Explorer Favorites from a Bookmark.htm file.

- Export existing Internet Explorer Favorites to a Bookmark.htm file.
- Import existing Netscape Navigator cookies from a Cookies.txt file.
- Import exported Internet Explorer cookies from a Cookies.txt file.
- Export existing Internet Explorer cookies to a Cookies.txt file.

To start the Import/Export Wizard, click **Import and Export** on the **File** menu in Internet Explorer, and then follow the instructions on your screen.
